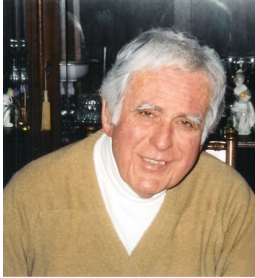


Program Founder

Jobs for Youth

The year-around, nonprofit Jobs for Youth program serves our young people, ages 14 to 21, regardless of background, socio-economic, or risk-level, at no cost to them or to employers. Youths learn to master job applications, prepare for interviews, create resumes, and they receive job and/or internship leads.

On average, Jobs for Youth serves 1,500 youth a year from throughout San Mateo County. Five sites in Daly City, Half Moon Bay, Menlo Park, Redwood City, and San Mateo assist both job seekers and employers.

A Success Story

Sonia Perdomo came to the Jobs for Youth program at PeninsulaWorks-Daly City when she was 16-years-old. Through the assistance of Ruby Tomas, Jobs for Youth program coordinator, she was able to obtain a job at a retail store. At the same time, she volunteered for JFY becoming the program's first intern.

After completing the internship, she was offered an Office Assistant position in the JFY program with San Mateo County.

Through the years, Sonia has helped teens just like herself successfully find employment.
